Step by step instructions for sending computer audio from MacBook Pro and MacBook Air into the classroom speakers

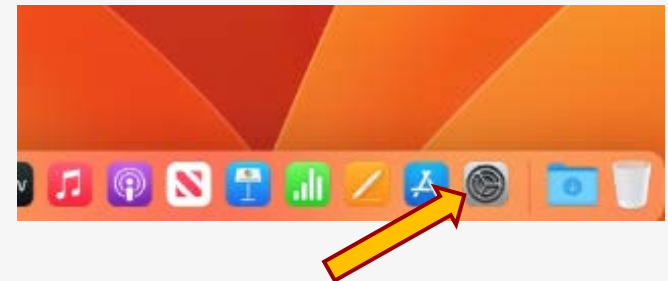
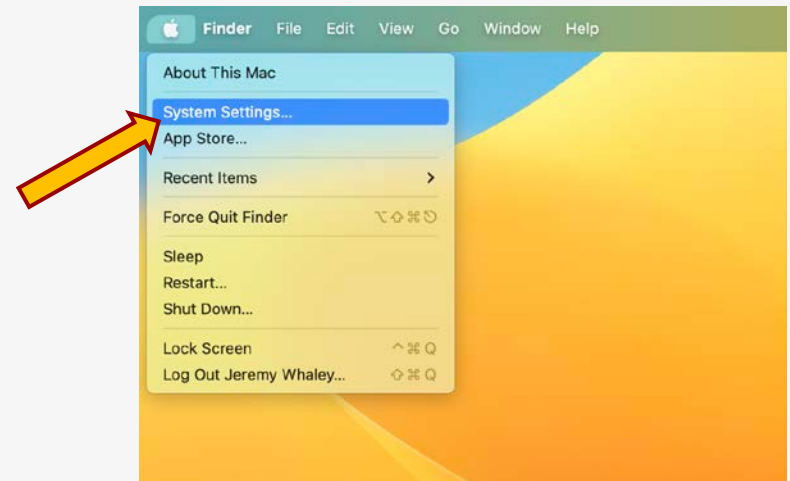


WPH Classroom Audio/Visual Instructions

Access System Settings:

Click the apple in the upper left corner of the home screen and choose “System Settings” from the pulldown menu.

System Settings can also be found by clicking the gear icon in your dock or in the launch pad.



WPH Classroom Audio/Visual Instructions

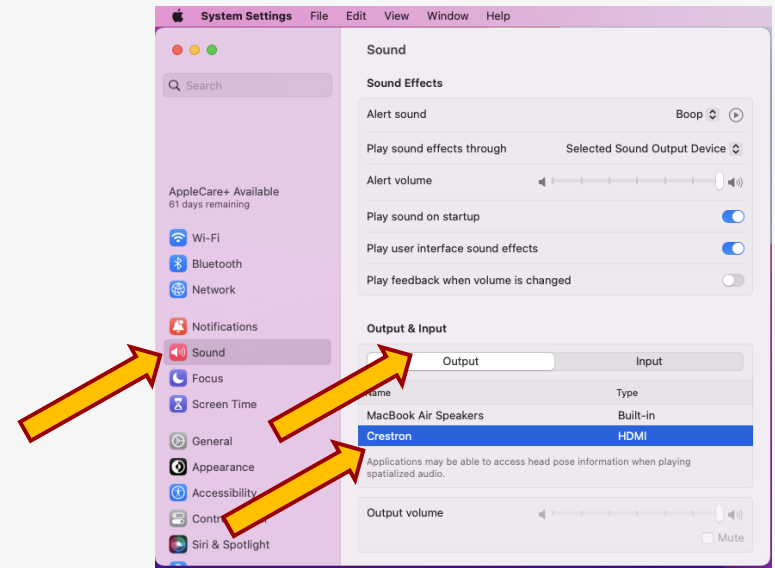
Access the Sound Settings:

Choose “Sound” from the list of choices in the system settings.

Choose “Output” to see speaker choices.

Select the Crestron output from the list of available speaker systems.

Test your audio by playing it into the room.



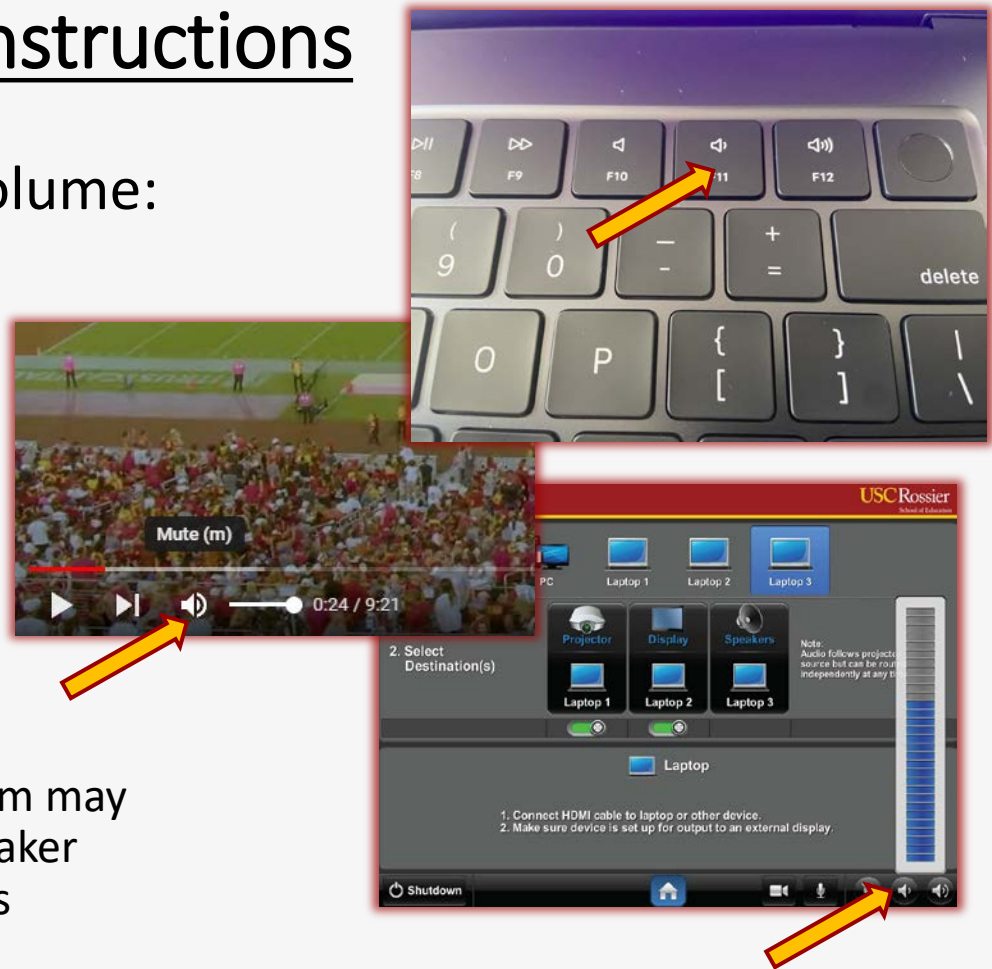
WPH Classroom A/V Instructions
